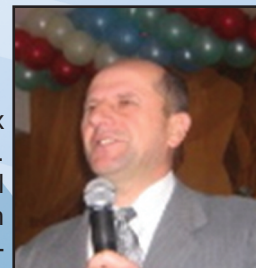

Regional Missions Program

When one supports a regional missionary, he is supporting the program and not the individual.
