The Tolstads were appointed to South Africa in September 2000 and then to Malawi in 2002. The country of Mozambique was added to their appointment in 2004. In 2006 they were asked to transfer to the country of Uganda due to the retirement of the Arlon Royer's. Twyla Tolstad is very involved in the work in Uganda as she directs the elementary and high schools in Kampala.

The church in Uganda is called the United Apostolic Church of Uganda and from the arrival of the Tolstads in 2007 the church has grown from thirty-one to over 600 churches in Uganda and from 3,000 constituants to over 50,000 people attending UACU churches. With ministerial training, seminars and doctrinal conferences the church continues to have great revival.
