As the local area is one of the worst areas in the UK for welfare recipients, illiteracy and joblessness, we plan on offering Life classes to the parents that will help them gain knowledge and understanding and ultimately improve

Missionary of the Month: Radovan and Tanya Hajduk



Radovan and Tanya Hajduk served on AIM in Novi Sad, Serbia, for two years before moving to Canada. Radovan was part of the platform and youth ministry at UPC of Oshawa, and Tanya helped in Sunday school. Radovan was born in Serbia and had a difficult childhood. His testimony and ministry have reached hundreds of people who have experienced abuse. Tanya is the daughter of missionaries Samuel and Pat Balca and was born and raised on the foreign field. The Hajduks served on AIM again in 2006. They spent nine months in the Baltic Republics and over a year in Croatia, where they presently are working with various home groups in order to pioneer a church. Upon returning to the field, they will be in Croatia's capital city, Zagreb, where they will establish a church, make new contacts and also reach into Slovenia to pioneer works.
