

Louis & Martha JOHNSON ETHIOPIA and RWANDA

Having been missionaries for the past twenty-five years in East Africa, Louis and Martha Johnson have worked many facets of missionary ministry. They started their ministry in Kenya teaching

in the Bible school and teaching seminars throughout the country. After traveling in neighboring Uganda to help pioneer the work, they seemed the natural choice to serve as furlough replacements there. They have also served as furlough replacements in the African island nations of Reunion, Mauritius and Seychelles. Their current missionary ministry centers in Ethiopia and Rwanda where Louis serves as superintendent of both works.

After actively pursuing registration of the church in Rwanda for more than seven years, the legal registration was secured in October 2011. They continued building the church by teaching Bible studies and establishing a church near the capital city of Kigali. They have a plot of land and plan to build a training center when they return to Rwanda.

Their work in Ethiopia includes conducting training sessions for pastors, and they continue to work closely with the leaders of the Ethiopian church.
