GENERAL CONFERENCE 2020

Our people rose to the occasion, sending a message to the darkness, and to our churches around the world, that God is on the throne and the church is alive in these last days. Since then, we have sent another missionary back to the field as funds have continued to come in. That means we have sent 16 missionaries back already this year. We have some still waiting, but we are believing God to continue to move upon His people that more missionaries will be sent this year.
