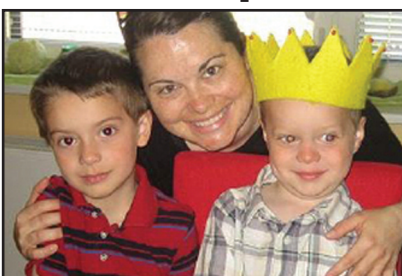
### Europe and the Middle East
