**PHILIPPINES** - Special appreciation to **Reverend Richard Flowers** (Mesquite, TX), and Missionary Allan Shalm for your sacrifice and your anointed ministry in Word! With a crowd of 6,000 people at the Philippine General Conference, the sounds of worship reverberated throughout the stadium. **JAPAN** - One hundred thirty one souls were filled with the Holy Ghost, and one hundred and seven were baptized in Jesus' name throughout Japan in 2016. Twelve new preaching points were started last year, and we just approved eight new works to be planted in four new prefectures this spring. **GUATEMALA** - This year we tried something new. Instead of having all the Sunday school teachers travel from all of Central America, we held three seminars in three different countries. The first one was held in the country of Panama where we had ninety-two teachers and pastors who came from both Costa Rica and Panama. In Honduras, there were ninety-six that came from Nicaragua and Honduras. The last one was held in El Salvador for the countries of Guatemala, El Salvador and Belize with 285 in attendance. This means that we had a total of 473 pastors and teachers that left the seminars knowing that they truly have been "Called" (our theme) to go about the Father's business.—**Lynn Jewett**

**ARGENTINA** - A lot of work and effort went into getting things ready for the new school year, but on March 13, the 2017 Bible school term started. The classrooms and dorms are full to capacity as young men and women have dedicated themselves to the preparation for the harvest field. The correspondence Bible school has grown to 120 students enrolled. These include many who would like to attend our on-site school, but are unable to do so.
