Mexico

In the early part of July, my assistant pastor, Bro. Alan Alvarez, sent me a message explaining that when he arrived to the church on Monday morning for ladies prayer meeting, someone had poured a salt line across the front of the church door and left dolls wrapped in red cloth. I immediately told him that a witch was challenging him and our church. I told him to confess any hidden sin in his life so he would be ready to engage the witch. After he and his wife finished praying, I instructed him to break the salt line, pull down the dolls and wait for the witch to show up. I told him that she would immediately sense the salt line was broken and show up in efforts to intimidate him. I told him that when she arrived, he needed to say "the LORD Jesus rebuke you" in a very calm but authoritative way. I instructed him not to engage in dialogue but in a prayerful and humble spirit, rebuke the enemy in Jesus' name. After four hours, I received a text that included these photos of the witch being baptized in Jesus' name. After her baptism, I told Bro. Alvarez to go to her home and clean it of any witchcraft objects. I also instructed him to ensure every object was broken. If at first she was afraid, he was to break one single small object so she would know she had nothing to fear. But after that, she, along with anyone else in her household were to break

every single one of the objects to break the h a b i t s a n d spiritual a t t a c k s . They threw

away four trash bags of broken objects. She has since testified of her baptism to all her ex-clients, and 148 of them have been baptized in Jesus' name!
