This summer, there are two Next Steps Assignments – Puerto Rico and New Zealand. Thirty-one young people, along with a great group of instructors, will be in these two locations for eight weeks of missions apprenticeship. ## Regional Missions Program

### Support of Regional Missionaries - \$5,000.00

Regional missionaries are national ministers approved and sent by the church of one of our six overseas regions. Their field of labor may be within their home region or in another region. Regional missionaries do not have deputation privileges in North America, and this program does not replace the missions effort of Global Missions. Rather, the Regional Missions Program serves to augment such efforts. When one supports a regional missionary, he is supporting the program rather than the individual.
