## Poland, Belarus and Ukraine

In 1992, shortly after the Iron Curtain fell in Eastern Europe, laypersons Ray and Judi Nicholls walked through an open door that led to Belarus. The new Belarusian government allowed them to conduct church services as they established Accelerated Christian Education schools. Within a short period of time Belarusians were receiving the Holy Ghost. In 1995, after serving as AIMers for three years, Ray received his ministerial license. Ray and Judi received missionary appointment to Belarus that same year.

After a term of service, they returned to Wisconsin and pastored there. However, their burden for global missions remained. In answering their call, Ray and Judi Nicholls were appointed as UPCI missionaries to Poland in September 2000. They have now established six churches in that nation. In 2012 the fields of Belarus and Ukraine were added to their portfolio and they are also working in Moldova. Ray was appointed as the Area Coordinator over the Baltics and CIS (former Soviet Union) in 2014. Their area includes twelve time zones and seventeen nations.
