Venezuela



Lonnie James Burton arrived in Venezuela as a two and a half-year-old missionary kid and was raised on the field. After graduating Indiana Bible College, he returned to Venezuela as an AIMer, working in the Bible school in Valera, opening new works, and pastoring four churches. He married Damarys and together they worked at the Bible school in administration and as teachers. They received full missionary appointment to Venezuela in 2004 and arrived back on the field in November 2008. They were given immediate oversight of the Valera Bible school. In four years of Bible school, they have seen over 230 students graduate. They also pastor a work in the Andes Mountains called La Puerta. Besides being involved in the education department of the church in Venezuela, they work with the missions department to establish more churches throughout the country.
