For two decades David and Kelley Dibble have served as missionaries in the North Pacific. After serving one year on AIM and seven years as an intermediate missionary in the Philippines, in 2008 the Dibbles changed fields as career missionaries to the Pacific sub-region of Micronesia which consists of five island nations: the Republic of Palau, the four Federated States of Micronesia (FSM), the Northern Mariana Islands (NMI), Guam, and the Marshall Islands. In 2010 Pacific Regional Evangelists was added to their appointment. David serves the UPC Micronesia as field superintendent, and the Pacific

Region as secretary. Following deputation, the Dibbles will return to this vast field of labor in 2021 to serve their fifth missionary term. Their vision for the UPCM aligns with the UPCI's Strategic Growth Initiative (SGI): train and license
