He also served as the men's coordinator at his home church for a number of years. Logan became involved with missions in 2008 and has been serving on the Associates In Missions program for the last five years. He was appointed as an Associate Missionary with the AIM program in 2014. Hannah, a missionary kid, grew up with a love for Africa and missions. She graduated from Indiana Bible College in May of 2015. Both Logan and Hannah were actively involved in missions on the AIM program when they met in 2015. After their marriage in 2017, they returned to the mission field to await their full-time appointment with Global Missions which occurred in September 2017.
