## **Biography**

Scott and Linda Guinn were attending Gateway College of Evangelism when they received their call to Spanish ministries. After they pastored a Spanish work in St. Louis, Missouri, for over five years, God called them to Mexico. In August 1996, they went as AIMers to northern Mexico City, where they pastored and opened new missions. Scott also served as district secretary, sectional presbyter, and Bible school teacher.

The Guinns received full missionary appointment in October 1998 to Mexico. In April 2000 they started a church in the capital city of Tuxtla Gutierrez, Chiapas, which has grown and produced three additional churches. They also supervised and trained leaders among three different Mayan Indian tribes in the mountains and jungles of Chiapas.

In March 2006 they accepted the responsibilities of the South Central District (the states of Puebla, Oaxaca, and Tlaxcala). They have started a church in Puebla, the fourth largest city in Mexico. The district has quadrupled in size since 2006.

They have both had the honor of being elected and serving in the national leadership in the work in Mexico. Scott served on the Executive and General National Boards of the United Pentecostal Church of Mexico, having been elected the Supervisor of the District and Zonal Bishop of the Zone. Linda has served as the National Ladies Director and National Sunday School Director in Mexico.

The Guinns have three sons. Nathan married Ashley in September of 2012, and they reside in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Nicholas has served as the Zonal Youth Promoter and as the National Youth Secretary of Mexico. He is raising AIM support to return to the mission field and has a passion for reaching the youth. Neil has been very helpful with the multimedia in the church in Puebla.

The Guinns are currently assisting the work in Cuba with Purpose Institute and conferences.
