at other locations when God miraculously provided a three-acre property with a warehouse and shop located just outside of Belfast.

They worked diligently, and over the next five years God helped them to establish a headquarters church in Northern Ireland with a part-time Bible school. The doors that have opened potentially lead to beginning works in Dublin, Belfast, Galway and Cork.
