To our faithful friends and supporters,

Much time has passed since we have sent out an update by mail due to our time here in the United States. We arrived in the U.S. February of last year for our interview with the Global Missions Board and shortly thereafter received our full appointment as long-term missionaries! We are thankful and humbled by the approval of our leadership and the endorsement of the fellowship.

Although we were unable to begin deputation travel until July due to the covid restrictions across the country, God has opened many doors for us to share our burden and to minister the Word across our fellowship. We have seen God move mightily in our services, backsliders pray back through, and several baptized and filled with the Holy Ghost all while forming lasting friendships. We cannot adequately thank the pastors and congregations who have opened their doors to us, invested in our ministry, and partnered with us in reaching the souls of Spain. As of the writing of this letter, we have raised nearly 70% of our budget! This for us is a testament of God's miraculous provision and the Kingdom-minded mentality of the church! **Please join us in praying that God will continue to make a way for us to return to the field as soon as possible!**

The Kingdom continues to move forward in Spain!

Meanwhile on the field, God continues to show Himself faithful. At the beginning of 2020 we were 12 works shy of seeing the national church's vision "Duplicarnos 2020" realized. In 2015, the goal was for each of the current 47 churches to plant a daughter work within 5 years, thereby doubling the number of churches. In 2020, despite the periodical lockdowns and restrictions that the

government enacted, we still saw 12 new works established and the vision that God had given His people was accomplished!

While we saw a doubling in the number of works, we saw a 50% increase in licensed ministers. This presents the work with a distinct need. Our focus and efforts must now be placed in the equipping and training of leaders for the harvest that God is giving us. Please pray with us that God will give our national leadership and us, as a missionary team, the strength and wisdom to meet this need. This is the direction God has given our leadership and the burden we feel to get back to the field as soon as possible.

The church that we personally worked to see planted in the city of El Prat has since been handed over to the leadership of a national minister, Pastor Eduardo Andreu. The building we were renting on Sundays has since been miraculously offered to the church 24/7 for only a 100 more euros a month plus utilities! This a tremendous blessing, as the location could not be better and it has already been soundproofed, which typically is a great expense to our churches in our metropolitan areas. Pastor Andreu and his family, upon gaining 24/7 possession of the building, have been able to make some tremendous changes which can be seen in the pictures above. God continues to add to His church in this city, and some of the newer contacts that were disconnected during the pandemic, have begun to make their way back! **Please cover this young work and this precious family in your prayers**
