They have started three churches, trained or helped train thirteen preachers, of which two are now pastors, one is an assistant pastor, three have recently gone to different cities and are teaching Bible studies or having regular services. Brother Richardson is the president of the Taiwan Pentecostal Bible College, which has been in operation for at least eight years. The Richardsons are working on reorganizing TPBC, translating materials from Global Association of Theological Studies, teaching in the TPBC two hours and preaching special services on Taiwan and in other countries.
