Biography

The Shalms received career missionary appointment to India in 1980. Because they could not obtain resident visas for India, they settled in Karachi, Pakistan, in 1982. In addition to pastoring an English congregation in Karachi, they travelled to India and Bangladesh regularly during their first term. Brother Shalm also established a correspondence course in the Hindi, Tamil and Malayalam languages during that first term.

The Shalms moved to Islamabad, Pakistan, in 1990, and after becoming General Superintendent of Pakistan in 1994, Brother Shalm planned a series of major crusades which saw the work grow from 325 churches and preaching points and 20,000 constituents to almost 3,060 churches and preaching points and 155,000 constituents

by the time they left Pakistan in January 2012. The Shalms helped to raise funds to buy property or construct 40 churches in India and Pakistan. They also raised funds to buy property for a Bible college in New Delhi, India, and to build a new Bible college in Lahore, Pakistan. One of Brother Shalm's major efforts was to prepare leadership and nationalize the work in Pakistan, which was accomplished.

The Shalms moved to Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, in January 2012 and are now travelling throughout the Asian and Pacific regions, teaching, evangelizing and promoting endtime Apostolic revival.
